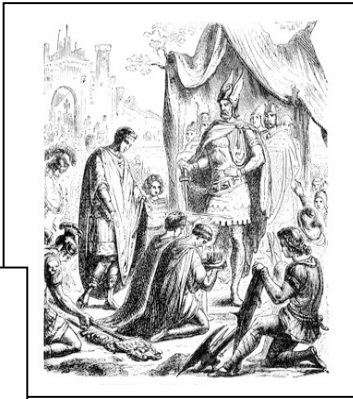




Odoacer being crowned as Emperor in 476 AD
