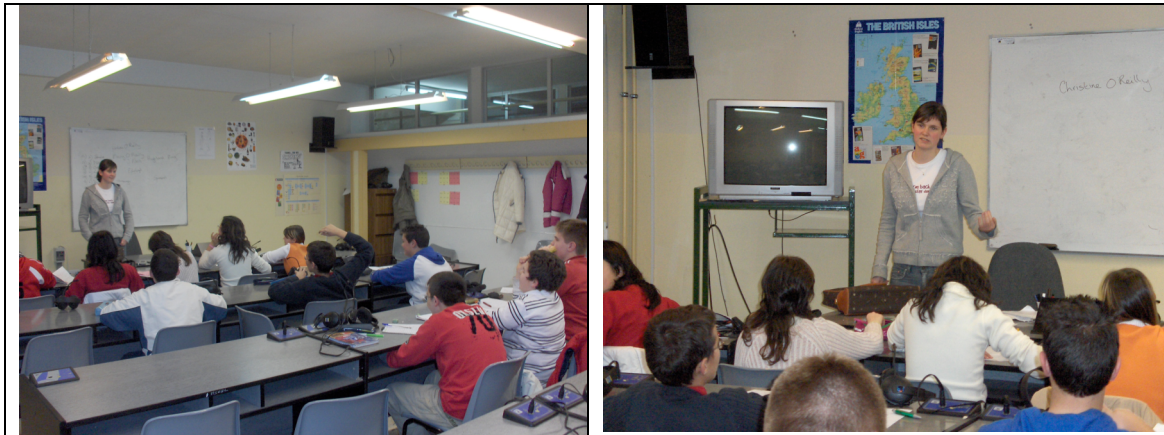


AN INTERVIEW TO OUR LANGUAGE ASSISTANT FOR THE BILINGUAL PROJECT
